Residential Services



Minute Man Arc offers a broad array of living options and supports determined by each individual's personal preference and the level of care that is needed.

Group Homes enable individuals to maximize their potential in a warm, inclusive setting that promotes personal well-being, health, community participation and friendship building. Residences serve adults who require 24-hour support with:

- Skills development and training
- Case management and support
- Recreation and community access

Independent Living serves individuals who have mastered many living skills or complete independence but still need enhanced support through case management for:

- Assistance accessing community services
- Training and networking
- Recreation

Shared Living helps participants become part of a family and community by matching them with a shared living provider. Individuals enjoy new activities and learn responsibility through:

- Monthly visits by the Shared Living Coordinator
- Access to the Behavioral Clinician and Residential Nurse
- Crisis and safety management

Adult Foster Care provides qualifying family members and caregivers with financial and clinical assistance in caring for their loved ones at home and out of residential institutions. Recipients must be at least 16 years old, receive Mass Health insurance, and require daily assistance from a caregiver who lives in the same home. Recipients must require assistance in mobility in or outside their home, bathing, dressing, toileting, eating or transferring.

- Nursing support and care management
- Assistance accessing community services
- Training and networking
