Through social and skill building opportunities, Recreation & Family Services works in coordination with families, day programs, school staff, and clinicians to ensure consistent care. Additionally, we present free caregiver trainings throughout the year.

What we offer:

• **Recreation** is designed to help individuals, ages 16 and up, to reach their personal goals, improve health and wellness, and create opportunities for socialization. A wide variety of classes and events help aging or working families seeking respite for their adult children who live at home. Individuals who live semi-independently and might feel isolated can benefit.

Recreation comprises a wide variety of enrichment activities such as bowling, fitness, ceramics, dance, yoga and Special Olympic sports. Unique events in the evening or on weekends promote socialization and provide a fun, low stress activity.

Caregiver Trainings are free presentations by community
experts on topics of interest to families who have a loved one with
a disability. Trainings are an important source of information that
support families in making informed decisions about their child's life,
adopting best practice care giving and provide a networking forum for
families managing similar circumstances.
